The Radio Flyer is published monthly by the Iowa City Aerohawks, a radio control flying club, and distributed free to members, by e-mail and USPS mail. Non-members may receive the newsletter by e-mail as a PDF file, by request. Spectators are welcome at the Aerohawks' flying field and clubhouse at 3860 Hebl Avenue, west on Melrose Avenue, west of HWY 218. The field lies on reclaimed land near the entrance to the Iowa City Landfill. New members are welcome at any time, regardless of level of skill.

Club Membership is \$60 annually. The Club requires that members volunteer to help with work projects from time to time. Members must also join the Academy of Model Aeronautics, (the Iowa City Aerohawks are AMA Chapter 824). Flying members must also have a valid FAA UAS Registration Certificate, and must complete the AMA TRUST Certification process. The Club has an active, free instructional program for beginners. Coralville Parade (July 4th)

The Annual Coralville July 4th Parade commences at 10:00 a.m. from the Coralville HyVee parking lot. The Aerohawks annually participate in this parade as a means of advertising our Community Involvement, and more specifically our free Airshow which is held the following Sunday (July 7, 2024).

The club float displays some of the aircraft club members fly. This requires temporary use of at least 12 club members aircraft for this



static display. Further, at least 10 club members are needed to walk along side the float, and hand out flyers to onlookers, inviting them to the Airshow.

If you are able to lend a plane, or to walk along side the float, join us in the Coralville HyVee parking lot at 9:00 a.m. for set-up, and 10:00 a.m. for the walk!



Airfield Preparation (July 6th)

To make the best impression on our audience, the club needs to clean-up and spruce up the airfield and its facilities. July- Flying with Others

Flying with other pilots.

-Communicate and listen!

Take off/landing directions and runway use. Walking on and off runway. Traffic pattern and rough altitude you are flying.

Flight issues; deadstick, radio, etc.

-Help one another out! Extra hands, spotters, or just advise can be greatly appreciated Be mindful of low passes, unpredictable/erratic flight, and speed with others in the air. **Spectators and Pets**

-Keep guests and non flying visitors safe and out of flying areas.

-Maintain a 500ft no fly line from any spectators and buildings.

-Focus on one thing at a time! Don't get distracted while flying or working with plane to answer questions or talk back.
