

September- Radio Connection



Frequency

While most people fly with 2.4 Ghz, be mindful of other transmissions. Active bind modes, smart bluetooth connections, and buddy box features within all systems.

Range Check

Maidens, repairs, new equipment, or infrequently flown aircraft are all good candidates to recheck connection on the ground to ensure connection when at a distance.

Failsafe

Take the time to program a failsafe if transmitter loses connection. Most failsafes will center controls and return throttle to idle.

Interference

High power transmissions and shielding materials within and around your aircraft can disrupt your radio connection.
