Club Liability Insurance

In regards to an upcoming scheduled event, a question had arisen regarding whether the club had overall liability coverage during a scheduled event, or was coverage available only to AMA members who are required by the club to hold an AMA membership to enjoy participation in club activities. The answer received clearly indicates that the club, as an organization is covered by AMA liability insurance during scheduled club activities: coverage which extends not only to club members but all other non-member participants, including non-member buddy box flyers (demonstration flights) as well as spectators and audiences.

<u>For the record</u>: Through its charter status with AMA, the club and the club officers are provided primary liability insurance coverage for the duties they perform associated with the club/chapter activities. The insurance industry calls this the "vicarious liability" for the acts of others or accidents caused by others. This coverage also applies to Contest Director and/or Event Manager, as long as the event is sanctioned. (ilonam@model aircraft.org – Feb 14, 2025)
